
## Watch carefully, fishing boats may be operating nearby you.

Fishing, such as the sea bottom-dragging net fishing or the boat-dragging net fishing, is very active in the Ise Wan. If it is the boat-dragging net fishing, water in between two boats in a pair is not navigable as they drag a fishing net cooperatively. In addition, as fishing boats usually fish close together in an area you can hardly distinguish two boats that are in a par.

If you notice these fishing boats, navigate carefully with followings taking into consideration.

- 1 Do not navigate through water in between two boats in a pair, or water in between a boat and its fishing buoy.
- 2 Keep the safe distance from the fishing boats in crowds, if it be possible.

## **Navigation in Ise Wan**

All Southbound or Northbound vessels of 500G/T or more navigating between the Nagoya-Ko and Irago Suido should pass the Ise Wan Light Buoys No.4, No.5 and No.6 observing them on your port side.

All Southbound or Northbound vessels of 500G/Ta or more navigating between the Yokkaichi-Ko and Irago Suido should pass the Ise Wan Light Buoys No.4 and No.5 observing them on your port side.

\*Ise Wan No.4,No.5 and No.6 light buoys are relocated. (Feb.2007)

- 1 Operate your AIS properly.
- 2 Keep watch on VHF channel 16 while you are in area.
