**The 21st High-Level Meeting Between
the Japan Coast Guard and the Korea Coast Guard
~ Strengthening Japan-Korea Inter-Agency Coordination and Cooperation ~**

The 21st High-Level Meeting Between the Japan Coast Guard (JCG) and the Korea Coast Guard (KCG) was held on Wednesday, December 10, in Incheon, Republic of Korea.

From the JCG, Commandant SEGUCHI Yoshio attended the meeting, and from the KCG, Commissioner General KIM Yong-jin participated.

Both sides reaffirmed their commitment to further strengthening collaboration and cooperation between the two agencies.

1. Background

Since the first high-level meeting between JCG and KCG in 1999, during which both agencies agreed to enhance future collaboration and cooperation, as well as to conduct regular mutual visits by both heads of these organizations, the high-level meeting has generally been held once a year.
